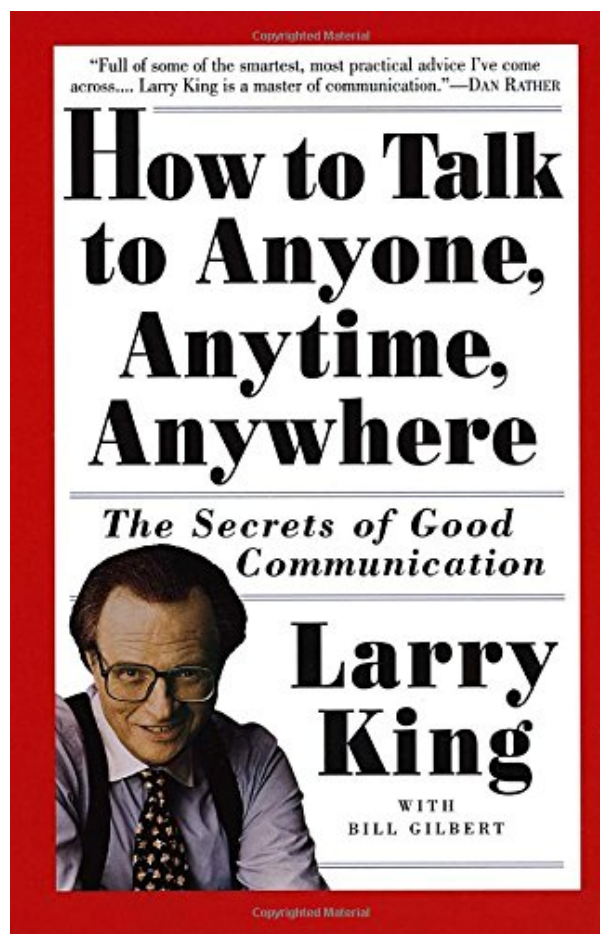

It does have some great suggestions, but for the most part, it serves as a reminder of the stuff you kind of know in the back of your mind, but don't always put into practice. I'm fairly young, so some of his illustrations were a little difficult for me to put into a complete context, having probably been about 5 when some of them occurred, although most of them were easy to follow, even without a complete knowledge of the background.
